

## **SUMMER INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME 2008**

With a view to spread awareness on human rights issues among University students, the Commission has been conducting "Summer and Winter Internship Programmes". The Internship Programme, which has commenced from the year 1998, is an annual feature held during the vacations of the Universities.

This year the "**Summer Internship Programme (SIP) 2008**" is scheduled from **19<sup>th</sup> May, 2008 to 18<sup>th</sup> June, 2008.**

The essential qualifications are: -

- *Students of the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> year pursuing 5 Years Integrated Law course.*
- *Students of the 3<sup>rd</sup> year pursuing 3 years L.L.B. course.*
- *Students pursuing Post-Graduation in **Human Rights, Political Science, Sociology, Criminology, Social Work and other related Social Science** of final year.*
- *Post- Graduate Diploma **in Human Rights is also eligible.***
- ***Girl candidates** are encouraged to apply.*

### **PRIORITIES FOR SIP 2008**

Kindly send the application by speed post/ fax/ email **superscribed on the envelope "Application for SIP 2008"**. **The 'Eligibility Criteria and the Application Form for SIP 2008' are available at [Annexure-I](#) & [Annexure - II](#) respectively.**

Please ensure that the application for SIP 2008 is **signed and sealed by the Head of the Department (HOD)**. **Applications submitted otherwise will not be accepted.** For those sending by e-mail, please get the authentication from the HOD and may send it separately.

**No application will be accepted after the deadline of [21<sup>st</sup> April, 2008](#).**

The selected interns are requested to bring **two passport size photographs**

## **PROGRAMME SCHEDULE FOR SIP 2008**

The medium will be **English**. The selected Interns would get the opportunity to work in different areas of Human Rights issues, including participation in the review of Programmes of the ongoing projects in the Commission. They will also get an opportunity to have interaction with legal luminaries, representatives of reputed NGOs as well as other National Commissions situated in Delhi. They will be required to study and scrutinise complaints, draft orders, present findings to the Commission, compile and analyze statistical data on human rights etc. The interns will be required to prepare reports on the topic of study assigned to them during the internship. **There will be field visits and project work during the weekends.**

### **STIPEND**

The selected interns from outside Delhi would be allowed claim restricted to ordinary second-class train fare to **New Delhi and back** to their place of study through the shortest route. They may also avail the Railway Student Concession benefits. For outside interns they would also be paid an amount of **Rs.5000/- (Rupees five thousand only)** as stipend. Students from Delhi and National Capital Region (NCR) will be entitled for **Rs.2500/- (Two thousand five hundred)** as stipend.

The selected Interns will have to make **their own arrangements** for **accommodation and transport at Delhi**. Those who need accommodation may kindly **contact the Resident Commissioner (RC)** of their respective States/UTs Bhavan in Delhi through the University or the State Government.

### **WEATHER CONDITIONS**

The selected Interns are requested to kindly bear in mind the very hot weather conditions (approximately 45<sup>0</sup>C) prevalent in Delhi during peak Summer.

### **TERMINATION**

Requests for leave (including for appearing in examinations) will not be entertained. **The internship is liable to be terminated in case of unauthorized absence or any act of unbecoming of an Intern of the Commission.**

It is requested that wide publicity to this programme may please be given amongst the Departments of **Law, Political Science, Sociology, Human Rights, Master in Social Work (MSW) and Criminology of your University**. Since only a limited number of students can be accommodated for the internship, the brief curriculum-vitae and application in the prescribed proforma may please be forwarded to **Dr. Sudershan Kumar Jain, Senior Research Officer (Training), National Human Rights Commission, Faridkot House, Copernicus Marg, New Delhi – 110 001.**

**Annexure - I**

**ELIGIBILITY FOR SUMMER INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME – 2008**

- i) **Students, who are studying in the 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> year of the 5-year Integrated Law Course, shall only be considered.**
- ii) **In case of the 3-year LL.B. Course, those students who are currently in the final year of the course shall be given preference.**
- iii) **Students pursuing Post-Graduate studies in Political Science, Sociology, Social Work (MSW) and Criminology would also be considered. However, preference would be given to those who are in the final year of the course.**
- iv) **Students pursuing Post Graduate Diploma in Human Rights would be considered provided they have done graduation.**
