9.	M.Sc Bio-Chemistry	Recognised B.Sc Bio-Chemistry Degree with 50% marks in the main subject.

e.	MA Women Studies	Degree with aggregate 50% in any subject with genuine interest in Women issues (Selection through entrance test and Group Discussion and interview)
f.	MLISc (2 year integrated course)	Any recognized degree with 50% marks.

Reservation:-

1. One seat in each of the courses is additionally reserved for ethnic natives of Lakshadweep Candidates.
2. Two seats (one in Science Department taken together and one in the Non-Science Department taken together except the course having entrance test) are reserved for the sports stars of outstanding performance. Such applications are to be submitted to the Director of Physical Education, University of Calicut.

Relaxation:-

1. SC/ST candidates need have only a pass in the qualifying Examinations.
2. OEC/OBC candidates are eligible for a relaxation of 5% marks in General.

General:

Application forms and other details except in the case of those courses involving entrance examination can be had on request made to the Head of the Department concerned alongwith the chalan receipt for Rs.50/- remitted to the Treasury/Authorised Branches of SBT under the appropriate Head of Account of the University of Calicut. However candidates residing outside Kerala can remit the cost of application by Indian Postal Order payable to the Finance Officer, University of Calicut, Calicut University (PO), 673 635.

In the case of courses involving entrance exam application form can be downloaded from the University website and submitted to Head of the Department concerned along with a chalan receipt for Rs.300/-.

Request for application forms by Post shall be accompanied by a self addressed and stamped Rs.10/- envelope and should reach the Head of the Department concerned at least 5 days prior to the last date fixed for the receipt of filled in applications.

The last date for the issuance of application in person and for the receipt of filled in applications by the Head of the Department concerned is 21.07.2008 (Monday).

Note: Holders of equivalent qualification recognized by the University only are eligible to apply.
