**PROSPECTUS FOR**

**B.Sc. Information Technology  
2008-2009**

CCSIT, University of Calicut has centers at Thrissur, Malappuram, Palakkad, Calicut and Wynad districts offering MCA, M.Sc. (Computer Science) and B.Sc. Information Technology courses. During the academic year 2008-2009 admissions are open for B.Sc. Information technology at the following centers.

**Eligibility for admission:**

1. Candidates seeking admission to the B.Sc. Information Technology Course should have passed the Plus Two of Kerala State or an equivalent examination, securing at least 50% marks with mathematics as one of the optional subjects.
2. Candidates belonging to SC/ST communities need only have a pass in the Plus Two or an equivalent examination having Mathematics as one of the optional subject.

3. Candidates who have appeared in the qualifying examination may also apply. Such candidates have to produce the original certificates and mark lists of the qualifying examination, if called for interview after the written entrance test.

**Age Limit**

There shall be no age limit for admission to the course. However, candidates have to produce a Photostat copy of the relevant page of SSLC, as proof of age.

**Duration of the Course and  
Teaching Hours.**

The Course is run in six semesters, with a maximum of one month's annual vacation, Classes will be held on five days in a week, from Monday to Friday between 9.30 a.m. and 4.00 p.m.

**Fee Structure**

- a) Cost of application form including fee for Entrance Examination : Rs.300
- b) Admission fee : Rs.2,500
- c) tuition fee per semester
  - i) Payment Seats : 6500/-
  - ii) Free Seats :
  - iii) Caution Deposit (Laboratory and Library refundable) : 1000/-
  - iv) Recognition fee : 50/-

- v) Matriculation fee : Rs. 50/-
- vi) Students Union fee : Rs. 75/-

On selection, candidates shall pay the admission fee, tuition fee for the first semester, caution deposit, recognition fee and matriculation fee (wherever applicable). Tuition fee in full shall be paid at the beginning of every subsequent semester. All remittances, other than the caution deposit are to be made to the Calicut University fund' by way of Demand Draft drawn in favour of the Finance Officer, University of Calicut, Thenhipalam Branch or by Chalan receipt at the University Counter, Calicut University Campus.

**Documents required at the time of  
admission**

Following original documents are required at the time of admission

1. Interview Card
2. SSLC Mark Book/Certificate
3. Plus two or Equivalent Certificate/ mark lists (all)
4. Mark list of other Examinations passed.
5. Community, income and Nativity certificate in the case of SC/ST/OEC/ OBC candidate eligible for fee concession/reservation (SC/ST students need not produce income certificate)

Candidates are requested to take sufficient number of copies of above certificates before submitting them to the CCSIT. Once the originals are submitted, they will be returned only after the completion of the course.

**Mode of Selection:**

All candidates, whose applications are found admissible, shall appear for an Entrance Examination/Interview/both conducted by the University. Details regarding the centre of Examination, date and time will be intimated to the candidates through admit cards. However the University will not undertake any responsibility for postal delays and loss in transmit. Those who do not receive admit cards at least three days before the scheduled date of examination are to contact the Assistant Registrar, CCSIT, University of Calicut.

The candidates shall appear for an entrance test of objective type questions based on general topics and optional at the Plus two or equivalent standard. Selection of candidates to the course will be made on the basis of index marks secured by them. The index marks have the following components.

- a) Marks scored in the Entrance Examination.
- b) 5 marks as weightage to candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from the Calicut University.

In case of any tie, marks obtained by the candidate in the optional subjects of the qualifying examination (other than languages) will be taken into account for the purpose of ranking.

Application form and prospectus can also be downloaded from the University website [www.universityofcalicut.info](http://www.universityofcalicut.info) and those who apply in the downloaded form should enclose a Chalan/Demand Draft for Rs. 300/- drawn in favour of the Finance, Thenhipalam along with the filled in a application, failing which it will summarily be rejected.

Completed application forms and admit cards together with a self addressed, stamped (Postage stamp worth Rs. 5/-) envelope should reach the Assistant Registrar, CEEC, PCC University of Calicut, Calicut University P.O, Pin-673 635.
