

Only 10% of SC/ST students will be eligible for the fee concession) Hence SC/ST students with the highest Rank in the qualifying exams will be eligible for the fee concession of the Govt.

- (vi) Fees once remitted will not be refunded under any circumstances

#### 5. CAUTION DEPOSIT

- (i) At the time of admission all students should deposit an amount of Rs.30,000/- (Rupees Thirty Thousand only) each and deposit will be refunded after the completion of the course without interest after deducting the charges towards damages and loss sustained if any, on the part of the student concerned.
- (ii) The students will have to remit the deposit to the Calicut University Fund by way of a crossed DD drawn in favour of the **Finance Officer, University of Calicut Payable at SBT Calicut University Branch.**
- (iii) In case the caution deposit is to be refunded to the candidates, who leave during the duration of the course, from such candidates an amount equivalent to 10% of the caution deposit will be deducted as handling chares.

#### 6. HOW TO APPLY

The application form and prospectus can be had from the Director, Centre for Health Sciences, Calicut University Campus, Thenhipalam and Sl. No. 1 and 2 can be had from the Administrator, IQRAA International Hospital & Research Centre, Malaparama, Calicut on written request accompanied by a crossed Demand Draft for Rs. 300/- drawn in favour of the **Finance Officer University of Calicut payable at SBT, Thenhipalam.** Request for application form by post should be accompanied by a self addressed and stamped (Rs.15/-) envelope (28x13cm size).

7. Filled in applications alongwith attested copies of certificates and two self addressed stamped (Rs.5/-) envelope (28x13cm) should reach the **Director, Centre for Health Sciences, Calicut University PO, Thenhipalam-673 635 on or before 30th June 2008.**

#### 8. GENERAL

- (i) Application in the prescribed form in original only is acceptable.

- (ii) Candidates need submit only one application for the various courses indicating the order of preference.
- (iii) Only photocopies of the mark lists, certificates and other documents need be sent along with the application.
- (iv) Candidates should appear for the entrance test/ Interview at their own expenses.
- (v) Candidates should bring the originals of the Certificates/Mark lists at the time of Interview/admission.
- (vi) The fact that a candidates has been called for interview does not confer on him/her any claim for selection. The admission lists will be provisional and subject to confirmation by the University.
- (vii) The University will not be responsible for non-receipt or late receipt of applications, interview memos and other correspondence regarding admission.
- (viii) If any Candidate who is provisionally selected, fails to report to the Officer concerned, on or before the specified time and date, his/her selection stands automatically cancelled without any further information.
- (ix) The University reserves the right to cancel any course for administrative or other reasons.
- (x) **Dealing with fraudulent information:**  
Admission to the Courses is purely provisional and if any anomaly/frauds detected at any later stage in the marklist or certificate produced by the Candidate his/her admission will be automatically cancelled and he/she will be removed from the Roll and appropriate legal action will be initiated by the University against such Candidates.
- (xi) **Agreement:**  
All students are required to sign an agreement with University/Institution to the effect that they shall be liable to abide by the rules and regulations framed by the University/Institution in connection with the conduct of the courses.

**PROSPECTUS – 2008-2009**

**1. INTRODUCTION**

The Centre for Health Sciences, University of Calicut has been established with the aim of providing quality education and training in various disciplines of Health Sciences. At present the administrative office of the Centre is functioning at Centre for Health Sciences, Calicut University Centre, Calicut University PO, Thenhipalam - 673 635

The Institution is developed without state subsidy as a fully self-financing Centre of Higher learning. Hence the finance for the infrastructure and expenses for the conduct of courses are to be met from the fees, service charges and deposits collected from the students.

**2. COURSES OF STUDY**

The Centre offers the following courses of study from the Academic Year 2008-09. Names of the courses, duration, eligibility for admission and the details of fee structure are as follows: **See Table 1 and Item 4 fees.**

**Notes:**

- (i) Usual relaxation in the required minimum marks will be allowed to candidates belonging to SC/ST and Other Eligible Communities.
- (ii) Rules of reservation prescribed by the University of Calicut will be followed for admission.
- (iii) (a) BSc. Nursing and BSc. Physiotherapy (BPT) courses are being conducted IQRAA International Hospital and Research Centre Vellimadukunnu, Kozhikode.
- (b) BSc. Medical Microbiology, BSc. Medical Laboratory Technology and BSc. Medical Biochemistry courses will be conducted at the Centre for Health Sciences, Calicut University, Thenhipalam.

**3. ADMISSION**

Admission to the Courses will be on the basis of merit. The percentage of marks obtained for Optional subjects in the qualifying examination together with the score in the entrance test conducted for the purpose by the University will be considered for deciding the merit.

The applicants who have passed the qualifying examination from the University of Calicut or those who have passed the qualifying examination from institutions within the jurisdiction of the University of Calicut shall be given a weightage of 10% of marks to their final score in the merit list.

**4. FEES**

- (i) The students are required to pay all fees as detailed in Table 1 as well as other fees detailed below:-
  - (a) Recognition Fee : Rs. 50/-
  - (b) Matriculation Fee : Rs. 50/-
  - (c) University Union Fee : Rs. 30/-
  - (d) Sports/Affiliation Fee : Rs. 75/-
- (ii) All remittances are to be made to the Calicut University Fund by way of Crossed D/D drawn in favour of the **Finance Officer, University of Calicut** Payable at **SBT, Calicut University Branch (code 200)**
- (iii) In the case of BSc. Nursing & Physiotherapy Courses the students have to remit the fee (except the miscellaneous fee of Rs.1000/-) to the account of IQRAA International Hospital, Malaparamba, Calicut. (Mode of remittance will be communicated alongwith Admission Memo)
- (iv) Examination fee is to be remitted as per University Notification from time to time.
- (v) 10% of the SC/ST students will be exempted from payment of Tuition Fee if the Govt. reimburses the same to the University/ Institution. They have to apply for fee concession in the prescribed form in order to get sanction from the District Development Officer within one month of the date of Admission. (As per the G.O. (M.S.)
