Classification of 2005 admission MCA candidate modified Regulation of 2006 admission made applicable to students of 2005 admission - Resolution of the Academic Council implemented - Order issued.

### ORDER

As per the paper read as (1) above all successful candidates passing all subjects in more than one attempt and securing 75% above marks or securing 60% and above marks in the first attempt shall be declared to have passed the MCA Course in First Class. All other successful candidates shall be declared to have passed the examination in Second Class.

A modification to the above regulation had been implemented from 2006 admission vide the paper read as (2) above in which the successful candidates passing all subjects within a period of 4 years from the date of admission to the course securing 60% and above in aggregate shall be declared to have passed in first class. It had also been specified that the modification is not applicable to the student of 2005 admission.

Several representations were received from the students admitted in 2005 to extend the benefit of modified regulation of 2006, to them also. But the concerned academic bodies did not approve their demand.

The matter was placed before the Academic Council on 13.02.2013 and the Academic Council vide the paper read as (3) above resolved that the modified regulations of 2006 admission MCA Course with regard to the matter of awarding classes to supplementary candidates who secure 60% within 4 years from the date of admission, be made applicable to the candidates of 2005 admission also.

The Dean Faculty of Engineering vide the papers read as (4) above has recommended to implement the above resolution of the Academic Council after levying prescribed fee from the beneficiaries and also to notify the matter through Paper notification and in the University website.

After considering the matter in detail the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor on 18.01.2014 has accorded sanction for the following.

- a) Implementation of the decision of the Academic Council and for issuance of revised MCA Degree Certificates, after canceling the Degree Certificates already issued by levying a fee of Rs. 1,000/- from each student.
- b) Arranging Press Release for the surrender of the MCA Degree Certificates issued earlier and issuance of new Degree Certificates to the beneficiaries after levying Rs. 1,000/-

It has also been ordered that such requests may not be entertained in future as the regulation of a particular period determines the mode of examination of that time and such anomalies should be informed to the Boards of Studies at the time of framing the regulation itself.

Orders are issued accordingly.
