ORDER

The Managing Trustee,Ammini College of Engineering, Kannampariyaram, Palakkad has submitted a request for increase in intake in the existing B.Tech Civil Engineering and B.Tech Mechanical Engineering courses from 60 to 120 during the academic year 2014-15 vide letter read as 1st.

The District Level Inspection Commission from University,vide paper read as 2nd,conducted inspection and recommended for increase in intake of B.Tech Civil Engineering and B.Tech Mechanical Engineering courses from 60 to 120 in each courses.

As per the paper read as 3rd,Govt.of Kerala has given NOC for increase in intake in the existing B.Tech Civil Engineering and B.Tech Mechanical Engineering courses from 60 to 120 in each courses during the academic year 2014-15.

As per the paper read as 4th,the AICTE has given approval for the increase in intake in the B.Tech Civil Engineering and B.Tech Mechanical Engineering courses from 60 to120 in each courses for the academic year 2014-15.

As per Letter read as 5th,the Govt.has informed that the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in its order dt.17.04.2014 in SLP(Civil)No.7277/14 has orderd that AICTE can proceed in accordance with

the approval process. Since the authority for the sanctioning of technical institutions is vested with AICTE, the moratorium from UGC has no relevance in the matter.

As per letter read as 6th, the Chairman, AICTE has informed that the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in its order dated April 17, 2014 passed in SLP Civil No.7277/2014 and ordered as under: " AICTE shall now proceed in accordance with the Approval Process Handbook for the Academic year 2014-15 in so far as the members of the petitioner Association and all colleges and institutions, situated similarly to the members the petitioner Association are concerned and necessary orders shall be issued by AICTE within ten days".

As per the Syndicate Resolution Item No. read as 7th, which approved the recommendations to start new courses in the existing colleges in the academic year 2014-15 as well authorized the Vice Chancellor to take appropriate decisions in this regard.

The Managing Trustee, Ammini College of Engg, Kannampariyaram, Palakkad vide paper read as 8th, has requested to grant additional intake in existing B.Tech Civil Engineering and Mechanical Engineering courses from 60 to 120 in each courses. An amount of ₹40,000/- (Rupees Forty Thousand only) was remitted as Affiliation fee vide Chalan No.141210197 dt.24.06.2014 at Finance Branch. The Principal and the Manager of the College has submitted a notarised undertaking to the effect that, they agree to carry

out faithfully the provisions of the University Act, Statutes, Ordinance and Regulations and Directions issued by the University from time to time.

Sanction has, therefore been, accorded by the Vice Chancellor for granting additional intake into the following B.Tech courses for the academic year 2014-15 in Ammini College of Engg, Kannampariyaram, Palakkad as given below:

Affiliation granted is strictly provisional and only for the academic year 2014-2015. Continuation of Provisional Affiliation for the ensuing years should be obtained after applying for the same along with required fee and extension of approval order from the apex body concerned.

In the light of the directions of the Supreme Court of India in WP (C)No.656/1998, the institutions shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form. In case of failure to prevent such instances appropriate action including withdrawal of affiliation of the college will be initiated.

Selection and admission shall be made only on the basis of the rules and regulations of the University and Government and on the basis of the directions issued from time to time, failing which the affiliation granted will automatically be cancelled. Admission to the next academic year shall be made only after obtaining prior permission from the University.

Orders are issued accordingly.
