ORDER

The Chief Executive Officer,Universal Engineering College,Vallivattom,Thrissur has submitted a request for starting a new B.Tech Computer Science & Engineering course during the academic year 2014-15 vide letter read as 1st.

The District Level Inspection Commission from University,vide paper read as 2nd,conducted inspection and recommended for starting a new B.Tech Computer Science & Engineering course during the academic year 2014-15 with an intake of 60 seats.

As per the paper read as 3rd,the Govt.of Kerala has given NOC for starting new B.Tech Computer Science & Engineering course in Universal Engineering College,Vallivattom,Thrissur-680123 for the academic year 2014-15 with an intake of 60 seats.

The AICTE has conveyed its approval for starting new B.Tech Computer Science & Engineering course for the academic year 2014-15 vide letter read as 4th.

Vide Letter No. D.O.No 14-9/2013 (CPP-II),the **UGC had decided to have a One-year moratorium on:**

a) Affiliation of fresh colleges providing technical education by Universities; b) Approval of increase in the intake of students in technical colleges.

As per Letter read as 5th,the Govt.has informed that the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in its order dt.17.04.2014 in SLP(Civil)No.7277/14 has orderd that AICTE can proceed in accordance withthe approval process. Since the authority for the sanctioning of technical institutions is vested with AICTE,the moratorium from UGC has no relevance in the matter.

As per letter read as 6th,the Chairman,AICTE has informed that the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in its order dated April 17, 2014 passed in SLP Civil No.7277/2014 and ordered as under: " AICTE shall now proceed in accordance with the Approval Process Handbook for the Academic year 2014-15 in so far as the members of the petitioner Association and all colleges and institutions,situated similarly to the members the petitioner Association are concerned and necessary orders shall be issued by AICTE within ten days".

The Principal, Universal Engineering College,Vallivattom,Thrissur- vide paper read as 7th, has requested for Provisional Affiliation for starting new B.Tech Computer Science & Engineering course for the academic year 2014-15.An amount of ₹20,000/-(Rupees Twenty Thousand only)was remitted as Affiliation fee vide Chalan No.141203057 dt.20.06.2014 at SBT,Edamuttom.The Principal and the Manager of the College has submitted a notarised undertaking to the effect that,they agree to carry out faithfully the provisions of the University Act,Statutes,Ordinance and Regulations and Directions issued by the University from time to time.

Sanction has, therefore been, accorded by the Vice Chancellor for granting Conditional Affiliation for starting B.Tech Computer Science & Engineering course for the academic year 2014-15 with an intake of 60 students.

Affiliation granted is strictly provisional and only for the academic year 2014-2015. Continuation of Provisional Affiliation for the ensuing years should be obtained after applying for the same along with required fee and extension of approval order from the apex body concerned.

In the light of the directions of the Suprerne Court of India in WP (C)No.656/1998, the institutions shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form. In case of failure to prevent such instances appropriate action including withdrawal of affiliation of the college will be initiated.

Selection and admission shall be made only on the basis of the rules and regulations of the University and Government and on the basis of the directions issued from time to time, failing which the affiliation granted will automatically be cancelled. Admission to the next academic year shall be made only after obtaining prior permission from the University.

Orders are issued accordingly.
