Eligibility for admission

Bachelor's Degree of this University or of any other University, recognized as equivalent thereto with a minimum of 45% marks for Part I, Part II, and Part III separately. Candidate belonging to Other Backward Communities will be eligible to apply, if they secure 43% for each part. SC/ST candidates need have secured only pass mark. Professional Graduate will be considered for admission provided they secure 60% marks in aggregate. Candidates awaiting the result of final year degree examinations are also eligible to apply. They will be considered for admission only if they secure the minimum prescribed marks and submit all documents in original at the time of interview.

Mode of Selection

Candidates for admission will be selected on the basis of an Entrance Test conducted by the university. Appropriate weightage will be given to holders of Degree with Journalism as main or subsidiary subject, holders of Diploma in Journalism and working journalist.
