**ORDER**

As per U.O. read as (1) above, the sports starts can avail of the higher percentage of grace marks from any one of the categories, if the basic conditions are fulfilled.

The Calicut University sports students organsiation, vide their representation read as (3) above, has requested to award grace marks on the same pattern and method as followed in the Mahatma Gandhi University.

The Asst. Director in charge of Director, Department of Physical Education, Vide his letter read as (4) above has stated hat the grace marks awarded to sports stars is very high in Mahmatma Gandhi University, when compared with the University of Calicut. The reason for this is that the cumulative percentage of grace marks of all the achievements during a single academic year will be considered for the award of grace marks to sports stars subject to a maximum of 25%. He has recommended to introduce the same pattern and method, as followed in Mahatma Gandhi University, to award grace marks to sports stars.

The standing committee on Academic Council at its meeting held on 22.2.2003, vide item No. 25, considered the question of recommending the award of cumulative percentage of grace marks to sports marks to sports stars (Non professional) for all their achievements during a single year and resolved to recommend to Academic Council for the award of cumulative grace marks for sports stars (Non-professional) for all their achievements in a single year subject to a maximum of 15%.

The academic Council as its meeting held on 27.3.2003, vide item No. I. 19, considered the recommendation of the standing committee on Academic Council for the award of cumulative percentage of grace marks to sports stars (non-professional) for all their achievements during a single year subject to a maximum of 15% and resolved to approve the recommendation of the standing committee on Academic Council for the award of cumulative grace marks for sports stars (non-professional) for all their achievements in a single year subject to a maximum of 15%.

Sanction has therefore been accorded to implement the above decision of the Academic Council.
