ORDER

Smt. Susan Rajan, a student of Government Engineering College, Thrissur in her representation Read as (1) above, has stated that she has represented Calicut University Shuttle Badminton Team, which secured 3rd position in the All India Inter-University Badminton Tournament held at Nagarjuna University in 2002-03 and winner of Kerala State Senior Badminton Championship in 2002-03 and 2003-04 for two years. She has further stated that the Kerala University is giving 5% grace marks to those just representing the University or the Kerala University is giving 5% grace marks to those just representing the University or state, for Engineering and other Professional examinations. She has therefore requested to take necessary steps to award grace marks to Engineering examinations of the Calicut University.

2. The Academic Council at its meeting held on 7.10.2004, vide item No. 1.14 considered the representation of Smt. Susan Rajan for the award of grace marks in Engineering Examination and resolved that a committee be constituted consisting of all Deans of Faculties of Professional Courses for taking a decision on this.

3. As per U.O. read as (3) above, a committee was constituted consisting of all Deans of Faculties of Professional courses for taking a decision on the matter of awarding of grace marks to Professional course students for outstanding performance in sports. The meeting of the Committee was held on 18.03.2005 and 19.04.2005 and submitted the recommendations.

4. The Academic Council at its meeting held on 18.06.2005, vide item No. 20, considered (i) the recommendations of the Committee constituted for taking a decision on the matter of awarding grace marks to professional course students for outstanding performance in sports and (ii) the representation from Smt. Susan Rajan for the award of grace marks to her I and II semester Engineering Examinations conducted by the University in July 2003 in recommendations of the committee of Deans of Professional courses for the award of grace marks to Professional course students for outstanding performance in sports. Further resolved that grace marks be awarded to Smt. Susan Rajan in the light of the recommendation of the committee.

5. Sanction has therefore been accorded to implement the decision of the Academic Council mentioned in Para 4 above.

6. The following shall be the norms for the awarding of grace marks to Professional course students for outstanding performance in sports.

- (i) Only those students who have represented the University, State or Country in officially sponsored championships or Tournaments and who have secured for themselves or for their team first, second or third prize will be eligible to apply for the award of grace marks.
- (ii) The competitions should be those approved by the Association of Indian Universities, the Kerala Sports Council or Sports Authority of India.
- (iii) Only bonafide and regular students of the professional courses (as certified by the Principal of the college) are eligible to apply for the award of grace marks.
- (iv) The candidates may apply for the award of the grace marks only once and that too only for the ensuing University written examination of the semester in which he/she secured the achievement.
- (v) The candidate should have appeared for that examination.
- (vi) These marks will not be considered for the purpose of ranking.
- (vii) The grace marks shall be awarded as follows.

- (viii) The grace marks will be calculated on the basis of the maximum marks in the written papers of the University Examination of the respective semester in which he/she secured the achievement.
- (ix) Only the highest eligible achievement will be taken into account in one semester.
- (x) The grace marks shall be distributed equally among the subjects appeared in the particular written examination.
