## ORDER

The Syndicate at its meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup> December 1993, considered vide item No.93-756, the question of award of grace marks to the sports stars, who represent the Calicut University in the various Inter University tournaments / Championships and resolved to award grace marks to such students of non-professional courses who participate in the various Inter University tournaments and Championships approved by association of Indian Universities in the light of the proposal made by the Secretary, Board of Physical Education as follows:-

1. Inter Collegiate in all events and games:

I Place :	5%
II Place :	3%
2. Inter University Participation/Inter University Selection : 7%
3. Inter University South Zone Semi-finals and qualifying for All India Inter University : 8%
4. All India Inter University (team events, individual events & Relays)

I Place :	18%
II Place :	15%
III Place :	12%
IV Place :	10%
5. Establishing New Inter University Records(Including relays) 1%
6. Representing State in National 5%
7. Winning National Juniors I Place : 12%  
Winning National Juniors II Place : 10%  
Winning National Juniors III Place : 8%
8. Representing Indian University –Seniors : 8%  
Representing Indian University –Juniors: 7%

9. Winning National Seniors - I Place	:	15%
II Place	:	12%
III Place	:	10%

10. Inter National Competitions:

The Basic qualification for the award of grace marks is representing Calicut University and satisfying the interest of the University. Those sports stars who do not get selection to the University teams, should have participated in University Coaching Camps, University selection trails and Inter Collegiate tournaments.

These marks shall be awarded to the candidate based on the maximum aggregate marks of the examination of the year of representation/Participation and it shall be distributed to his/her advantage at the time of the finalization of the result before awarding moderation marks, if any. The Association of Indian Universities approved N+1 , N+2 candidates will also be eligible for these grace marks just as regular students. These marks need be awarded only to holders of Merit Certificates and those who are duly recommended by the University Department of Physical Education.

This orders come into force with effect from 1993 April/May examination onwards.

The sports stars can avail of the higher percentage of grace marks from anyone of the categories, if the basic conditions are fulfilled.

This order will supercede all orders issued from this office in this regard.
