Department of Physical Education - Recommendations of the meeting of the Monitoring Committee for the working of the Department of Physical Education held on 29.07.2015 - Approved - Syndicate Resolution implemented - Orders issued

ORDER

The Monitoring Committee for the working of the Department of Physical Education in its meeting held on 29.07.2015 has considered the the following items and resolved as follows:

1. To receive three entries in 100 m & 400 m as done in the case of events 'Walk' and 'Half marathon' in the Inter Collegiate Athletic meet (M&W) .
2. To conduct semi finals for 800 m & 1500 m in Men section in inorder to avoid injuries during the events caused as the result of performance by all the participants together in the Inter Collegiate Athletic meet (M&W)
3. To to stop the time trials in 110 / 100 & 400 m Hurdles during Inter Collegiate Athletic meet (M&W), as many of the best athlets could not perform well during the Heats& Finals since they were forced to participate in the events along with sub standarad athlets
4. To conduct Inter Collegiate Taekwondo championship with one entry in one weight category from one college instead of the present practice of two entries in one weight category from one college without compelling the required belt
5. To accord sanction to the Department of Physical Education to dispose the damaged sports goods, equipments, furniture and electronics gadgets of the department as per the list prepared - Recommended to place before the Syndicate to permit the Director of Physical Education for the disposal and auction after appraising the whole items by a committee consists of Director of Physical Education (Convenor), University Engineer, Instrumentation Engineer & Assistant Director of Physical Education.
6. To reccomend to place before the syndicate for approval the matter of prohibiting the affiliated colleges from collecting users fee for using their grounds by the organising colleges to conduct Inter Collegiate Tournaments of University of Calicut
7. To recommend to place before the Syndicate and Academic Council for consideration the matter of awarding 100% of eligible grace marks (GM) / grace grade points (GGP) to each semester of the year, since the GM/GGP has been reduced to 50% as the result of introducing semester system.

8. To recommend to place before the Syndicate and Academic Council for consideration the matter of awarding 0.6 Grace Grade points or 1% of Grace Marks the 3rd position holders of the Calicut University Inter Collegiate Tournaments.
9. (The item has been kept for re- submission)
10. To make sports stars ineligible who have completed one UG Degree course successfully from any university and joined another UG Degree course other than professional course, from participating in Inter Collegiate Tournaments / University Selection Trials / Inter University Tournaments in line with AIU rules.
11. To recommend to place before the Syndicate for consideration the report by Dr.K.P.Manoj on the matter to consider the question of honouring the Gold / Silver medal winners in the Inter Collegiate Tournaments at the venue itself.
12. Considered the report of Director of Physical Education and Asst Director of Physical Education regarding issuing of Merit Certificates to the winners of first three places in the Inter Collegiate zonal level competitions. As per report, the details are to be sent to the university by zonal conveners and these winners are not eligible for grace marks. The committee recommended to place before the matter before Syndicate for consideration for entrusting the Zonal Conveners for preparing the certificates with the logo of the University and get the signaure of the Director/Assistant Director of Physical Education on them.
13. The committee resolved to recommended to place before the syndicate to consider the matter of enhancing the existing Officiating and Conduct charges to the rate proposed by the Department of Physical Education for the conduct of Inter Collegiate Zonal/Inter Zonal Tournaments and University Team Selection Trials

The Syndicate in its meeting held on 24.08.2015 has considered the recommendations of the Monitoring Committee vide item No. 2015.1122* and resolved to approve the Items except Agenda item No. 8.

The Vice-Chancellor, vide order dated 06.09.2015 has granted permission to implement the resolutions of the Syndicate.

The resolutions of the Syndicate are, therefore, implemented and the following orders are issued :

1. Three entries can be received in 100M & 400M like in Walk and Half Marathon in the Inter Collegiate Athletic meet (M&W).
2. Semi finals can be conducted for 800M & 1500M in Men section in order to avoid injuries during the events in the Inter Collegiate Athletic meet (M&W).
3. The practice of conducting time trials in 110/100 & 400M Hurdles during Inter Collegiate Athletic Meet (M&W) has been stopped .
4. A college can submit only one entry in one weight category for the Inter Collegiate Taekwondo championship. Colour of the Belt is not a criteria for the participation. All students of the affiliated colleges are eligible to participate in the Inter Collegiate Taekwondo championship.
5. The Director of Physical Education is permitted to dispose and auction the damaged sports goods, equipments, furniture and electronics gadgets of the department as per the list prepared by the department after appraising the whole items by a Committee consists of Director of Physical Education (Convenor), University Engineer, Instrumentation Engineer & Assistant Director of Physical Education.
6. The affiliated venue colleges are prohibited from collecting users fee from the organising colleges of the Calicut University Inter Collegiate Tournaments for using their grounds.
7. The matter of awarding 100% of eligible grace marks (GM) / grace grade points (GGP) to each semester of the year is approved by the Syndicate and to be placed before the Academic

Council for approval.

8. The matter of awarding 0.6 grace grade points or 1 % grace marks to the IIIrd position holders of the Calicut University Inter Collegiate Tournaments is not approved by the Syndicat
9. The certificates are to be issued at the venue of the Inter collegiate events
10. Those sports stars who have completed one UG Degree course successfully from any university and jointed another UG Degree course other than professional course, are not eligible to participate in the Inter Collegiate Tournaments/ University Selection Trials / Inter University Tournaments.
11. The Gold/Silver medal winners in the Inter Collegiate Tournaments will be honoured at the venue iteself.
12. Merit Certificate will be issued by the Zonal Conveners to the first three position holders of the Inter Collegiate Zonal level competitions and its details will be sent to the univesity by the Zonal Conveners. They will not be eligible for grace marks.
13. The existing Officiating and Conduct charges of the Inter Collegiate Zonal/Inter Zonal tournaments and University Team Selection Trials are enhanced as per the Annexure A & B attached.

Since there is a confusion regarding the mode of issuing certificates vide item No. 9 the same will be resubmitted clarification. All the other items are implemented and orders are issued accordingly.
