ORDER

The Assistant Director I/C of Director, Department of Physical Education has forwarded a proposal for a new scheme for the award of cash award every year to colleges which secures the first three positions in points from the number of students who won the first three positions in the All India Inter University Tournament/Championship. The college which scores the highest points from the number of students who won the first three positions in the All India Inter University Tournaments/Championship will be given points as given below:

| ii) | All India Inter University Individual II | : 45 points |
| iii) | All India Inter University Individual III | : 30 points |
| iv) | All India Inter University Team I (each member) | : 45 points |
| v) | All India Inter University Team II (each member) | : 30 points |
| vi) | All India Inter University Team III (each member) | : 15 points |

No other achievement at any level will be considered for counting of points for this cash award. The college which scores the highest number of points in an academic year will be awarded Rs.50,000/-. The second best college on the basis of above criteria will be awarded Rs.40,000/- like wise Rs.30,000/-, Rs.20,000/- and Rs.10,000/- for the third, fourth and fifth best colleges respectively. The total expenditure in this regard will come to Rs.1,50,000/- in an academic year.

The Cash Award can only be utilized for the development of Sports Infrastructure facilities in the colleges and cannot be utilized for giving awards to the position winning students. The utilization certificate in this regard from the award winning colleges has to be forwarded to the Head of the Department of Physical Education before the processing of the application for Cash Award of the next academic year. If the utilization certificate of the preceding year is not submitted, the claim of a college for cash award will not be considered.

The Assistant Director in charge of Director, Department of Physical Education has requested to approve the above explained new scheme for the award of cash award to colleges every year and to sanction a new budget head in Part I Non Plan named "Cash Award to Colleges" with an allocation of Rs.1,50,000/- from the financial year 2008-09 onwards.

The syndicate at its meeting held on 03.12.2007 resolved vide Item No. 2007.962 to Institute cash award worth Rs.30,000/-, Rs.20,000 and Rs.10,000 respectively to the colleges which secure the 1st three positions as suggested by the Department of Physical Education.

Sanction has, therefore been accorded the Vice-Chancellor on 23-01-2008 to implement the above decision of the syndicate to institute. Cash award every year, worth Rs.30,000/-, Rs.20,000 and Rs.10,000 respectively to the colleges which secure the 1st three positions as suggested by the Department of Physical Education. Sanction has also been accorded to sanction new budget head under Part I Non-Plan named “Cash Award to Colleges” from the year 2008-09 onwards.
