**ORDER**

The Steering Committee on CBCSS (UG), vide paper read as (1) made certain amendments in the existing Regulations of Choice Based Credit Semester System (CBCSS) under School of Distance Education w.e.f 2011 admissions stating that candidates possessing a degree under yearly pattern cannot apply for additional degree in the CCSS pattern and such students should appear afresh for all courses including common, complementary, core and open courses for students with CCSS & Pre-CCSS degrees (Annual pattern)

Vide paper read as (2) students with Pre-CCSS degrees have been permitted to register for additional degrees, provided, they satisfy the eligibility criteria of the degree they apply for and they have been exempted from appearing for Common Courses.

Vide paper read as (3) clarifications have been sought for by School of Distance Education regarding the above mentioned University Orders pointing out that they seem to be contradictory.

Steering Committee on CBCSS UG-2014, vide paper read as (4), considered the matter and made clarifications in permitting students with CCSS & Pre-CCSS degrees (Annual pattern) to register for Additional Degrees.

Academic Council, vide paper read as (5) approved the resolution of the Steering Committee on CBCSS UG.

Vide paper read as (6), U.O issued with the following clarification: to permit students with CCSS & Pre-CCSS degrees (Annual pattern) to register for Additional Degrees, provided, they satisfy the

eligibility criteria of the degree they apply for. Additional Degree candidates shall be exempted from Common Courses in which they have already taken and shall register for additional degree in 3rd semester when it is notified and such candidates have to complete the course within two academic years.

SDE, vide paper read as (7), sought clarification in the U.O read as (6).

Steering Committee on CBCSS UG-2014, vide paper read as (8), considered the matter and made clarification to the U.O read as (6).

Vide paper read as (9), Academic Council approved the minutes of the Steering Committee.

Vide paper read as (10), permission has been granted by Vice Chancellor to implement the resolution of Academic Council.

Sanction has, therefore, been accorded to permit students with CCSS & Pre-CCSS degrees (Annual pattern) to register for Additional Degrees, provided, they satisfy the eligibility criteria of the degree they apply for. Additional Degree candidates shall be exempted from Common Courses in which they have already taken and shall register for additional degree in 3rd semester when it is notified and such candidates have to complete the course within two academic years. It is further clarified as follows:

- The candidates can join for additional degree course through SDE registering in 3rd semester. They have to appear for their I and II semester core & complementary papers along with regular candidates (as regular papers).
- Yearly pattern students can join additional degree course through SDE for B.A/B.Sc with the exemption of the Common Course. Such candidates should have a minimum of 38 credits in Part I & Part II Additional Language.
- Language Reduced Programme (LRP) Yearly pattern candidates have no exemption in Common Courses and they have to appear for all courses for their additional degree. In the case of LRP candidates seeking admission to LRP programme, they need not appear for common courses.
- Regular pattern students joining for additional degree in LRP should acquire 120 credits after completing the Programme. They can transfer eligible credits of common courses if all conditions satisfy.

Orders are issued accordingly.
