PROLOGUE

The University of Calicut (the largest University in Kerala) established in 1968, the second University to be set up in Kerala was opened as a part of the affirmative policy of the government in response to the challenges offered by the geo-political nature of Malabar. It aimed to bring higher education within the purview of one and all.

At present the University has 36 post graduate departments and 426 affiliated colleges and is the largest residential cum affiliating University in Kerala. It has slowly but steadily branched out and now has extension centres at Thrissur, Lakshadweep and Vatakara.

PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

Courses:

The undergraduate Programme shall include 4 types of courses, viz **Common Course (Code A)**, **Core Courses (Code B)**, **Complementary Courses (Code C)**, & **Open Courses (Code D)**

Common courses: In general, every under graduate student shall undergo 10 common courses (Total 38 credits) chosen from a group of 14 common courses listed below, for completing the programme:

1. Common English course I – The Four Skills for Communication
2. Common English course II – Modern Prose and Drama
3. Common English course III – Inspiring Expressions
4. Common English course IV – Readings on Society
5. Common English course V – Native Media in English
6. Common English course VI – Reading fiction and non-fiction

7. Additional language course I (Malayalam, Hindi, Arabic, Urdu, French, Sanskrit)
8. Additional language course II
9. Additional language course III
10. Additional language course IV

11. General course I – Basic Numerical Skills
12. General course II – General Informatics
13. General course III – Entrepreneurship Development
14. General course IV - Banking and Insurance (for B.Com/BBA)

Open Courses : There shall be One Open course in the V Semester. The student can opt one open course from a pool of open courses offered by the University except his/her Core subject.

SECTION – 2

DETAILS OF FEE TO BE REMITTED BY UG STUDENTS ALONG WITH THE APPLICATION AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION

- I. Private Registration fee - ₹ 1,500/-
- II. Matriculation Fee - ₹ 125/- (for those who are enrolling in Calicut University for the 1st time.)
- III. Re-matriculation fee - ₹ 175/- (for those who have migrated from Calicut University to other Universities).
- IV. Recognition fee - ₹ 125/- (for those who have qualified from Boards/Universities of other states).
- V Spot registration fee(if availing the facility)- ₹ 50/-

NB: Fine (for correction in the application) - ₹ 100/- as service charge from all defaulting candidates except for name and Date of Birth correction

Blind candidates are eligible for fee concession on production of Medical Certificate.

MARK RELAXATION TO THE OBC/OEC/SC/ST CANDIDATES

On production of caste certificate, OBC/OEC students will be given 5% or 3GPV relaxation to the mark required for admission. SC/ST candidates need get only pass for admission.

SECTION - 3

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE FOR UG COURSES

Application is to be submitted online.

Candidates are requested to read carefully the prospectus for details of courses and fee before filling the online applications.

- a) Remit the required Private Registration fee /Matriculation fee (if applicable)/ Recognition fee (if applicable) and Re-matriculation fee (if applicable)/by way of chalan. *(for details see section 1 & 2)*
- b) Log on to www.universityofcalicut.info with chalan receipt and a recent passport size photograph for uploading in JPEG format.
- c) Click the link **“Private Registration 2016-17 for UG courses”** to get the online application.
- d) Fill in all the columns and submit.
- e) Take the printout of the application.
- f) Attest the photo in the printout by a Gazetted Officer and forward to the Deputy Registrar, Private Registration, SDE building, University of Calicut, Calicut University PO, Pin 673635 with following documents.
 - 1) Original chalan receipt for the required fee.
 - 2) Original Transfer Certificate.
 - 3) Original and copies of Qualifying Certificate and marklists.
 - 4) Self attested copy of SSLC/Equivalent for proof of age and Date of Birth.
 - 5) Those who are eligible for mark relaxation on the basis of caste should submit community certificate (Original) along with the application.
 - 6) One Self addressed stamped (₹32/) envelope of size 30 cm x 25 cm (If not availing facility of spot admission)
 - 7) One self addressed stamped (₹5/-) envelope (12 x 5 inches)
 - 8) **Last date for applying online: 20.10.2016**
Last date of receipt of Printout of applications with necessary documents 25.10.2016
 - 9) Certificate from the authority for relaxation in minimum marks in case of teachers, Govt. employees, University employees etc.

Candidates should apply for the first semester examination by remitting the required fee as and when notified.

SECTION – 4

An identity card, with the private registration number will be made available to the student who gets registered for the programme. This card should be kept till the completion of the course. The students should bring the identity card whenever they come to the Private Registration department, University of Calicut.

If the original card is lost duplicate card will be issued collecting a fee of ₹ 100/-.
