ADMISSION RULES FOR PG PROGRAMMES(2016-17)

MA/M.Sc./M.Com.

General Rules:

IMPORTANT: Orders regarding amendments, modifications, additions, deletions etc., issued by the University from time to time, are to be timely incorporated to these Rules.

- Candidates who have appeared for the qualifying examinations at an annual or its preceding supplementary examinations held by the examination authorities alone are eligible to seek admission to any PG programme of study under the University. Candidates are not eligible to seek admission to a PG programme in a particular academic year if they have passed the qualifying examination in the supplementary/September examination in the same academic year to which they seek admission.
- The interval between the date of passing the qualifying exam and the exam for which admission is sought should not be less than the normal period prescribed for the programme of study.
- Children of service persons who are awarded gallantry decorations in the Vir Chakra either in person or posthumously and also on Non-Decorated service Personnel who are killed in action will be exempted from the requirement of minimum marks prescribed for admission to M.A/M.Com/M.Sc. Programmes. (GA/G2/28074/1984 dated 01.12.1986)
- Equivalency/Recognition of the qualifying examinations taken from other Universities/Institutions should be confirmed strictly before making admission of students.
- The equivalency certificates/Recognition certificates issued from this University are of a general nature, without verifying originals of the qualifying certificate and other records of the candidates. Therefore the Admitting Authorities have to verify properly and ensure the genuineness of the claims of the candidates regarding the qualifications, mode of study, duration of the programme 10+2+3 (pattern) etc. before granting admission.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. **Students under mark System:** Eligibility of each PG programme is specified based on the eligible UG programmes and the % marks obtained in different parts(eg: part 1, part II, part III etc.). Relaxation in the requirement of minimum marks upto 5% for OBC/OEC is applicable. SC/ST candidates need get only a pass in their qualifying examination for admission to the Post Graduate Programmes. Eligibility criteria are given along with the description of each course.

2. **Students under grade system (CCSS):** For each PG programme there will be a set of eligible UG programmes. Either of the below given options (Option 1 or Option 2) will be the general criteria for fixing the eligibility for each programme. **Option 1** is based on the overall CGPA and Option 2 is based on the CGPA in each core and complementary courses. The following system is provided for a CGPA with 0-4

DETAILS OF ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

M.Com

1. **Students under Marks Scheme:**

B.Com/BBA/BBS/BBM Degree of this University or equivalent degree with at least 45% marks for part III. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

2. **Students under Grade Scheme (CCSS):**

B.Com/BBA/BBS/BBM Degree of this University or equivalent degree with **OPTION I**

MA Economics

1. **Students under Marks Scheme:**

BA Degree of this University with Economics/Foreign Trade/Development Economics(Main) or equivalent degree with at least 45% marks for Part III (excluding subsidiaries). OR B.Sc. Degree of this University with Statistics/Mathematics(Main) or equivalent degree with at least 70% marks for Part III (excluding subsidiaries). OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

2) **Students under Grade Scheme (CCSS)**

BA Degree of this University with **Economics/Foreign Trade/Development Economics(Main)** or equivalent degree, **OR B.Sc. Degree** of this University with **Statistics/Mathematics (Main)** or equivalent degree, with **OPTION I**

MA History

1. **Students under Marks Scheme:**

Any First Degree Examination of this University or equivalent degree with at least 45% marks for Part III (excluding subsidiaries). OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

2. **Students under Grade Scheme(CCSS):**
Any First Degree Examination with **OPTION 1.**

4) **MA Philosophy**

1. **Students under Marks Scheme:**

Any UG Degree of this University or equivalent degree with at least 45% marks for Part III (excluding subsidiaries). OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

2. **Students under Grade Scheme(CCSS):**

Any UG Degree of this University or equivalent degree with **OPTION 1.**

5) **M A Political Science**

1. **Students under Marks Scheme:**

BA Degree of this University with Political Science (Main)/Any other programme with at least one complementary course in Political Science with 50% marks in Part III. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

2. **Students under Grade Scheme(CCSS):**

B.A. Degree of this University with **Political Science (Core)/Any other programme with at least one complementary course in Political Science** or equivalent degree with **OPTION 1.**

6) **M A Sociology**

1. **Students under Marks Scheme:**

Any UG Degree of this University or equivalent degree with at least 45% marks for Part III (excluding subsidiaries). OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

2. **Students under Grade Scheme(CCSS):**

Any UG Degree of this University or equivalent degree with **OPTION 2.**

7) **MA Arabic**

1. **Students under Marks Scheme:**

BA Arabic/Afsal-ul-ulama/Double Main with Arabic Degree with at least 45% marks in Part III or **BA/B.Sc (excluding alternative pattern) Degree with Arabic in Part II** with at least 45% marks of this University or equivalent degree. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

2. **Students under Grade Scheme(CCSS):**

BA Arabic/Afsal-ul-ulama/Double Main with Arabic (Core) Degree or BA/B.Sc (excluding alternative pattern) Degree with Arabic as Common Course of this University or equivalent degree with **OPTION I.**

8) **MA English Language & Literature**

1. **Students under Marks Scheme:**

BA English Lang. & Litt./BA English & History/BA Functional English with at least 45% marks for **English Main Papers or BA/B.Sc (excluding alternative pattern) Degree** with at least 45% marks in **Part I English**, of this University or equivalent degree. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

2. **Students under Grade Scheme(CCSS):**

BA English Language & Literature/BA English & History/BA Functional English/ or BA. B.Sc (excluding alternative pattern) Degree with English as common course of this University or equivalent degree with **OPTION I**.

9) **M A Hindi (Language & Literature)**

1. **Students under Marks Scheme:**

BA Hindi Language & Literature/Functional Hindi/Hindi & History (Main) Degree with at least 45% marks for Part III or **BA. B.Sc (excluding alternative pattern) Degree with Hindi in Part II** with at least 45% marks of this University or equivalent degree. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

2. **Students under Grade Scheme(CCSS):**

BA Hindi Language & Literature /Functional Hindi/Hindi & History (Core) Degree or BA. B.Sc (excluding alternative pattern) Degree with Hindi Common Course of this University or equivalent degree with **OPTION I**.

10) **MA Malayalam**

1. **Students under Marks Scheme:**

BA Malayalam Language & Literature (Main) Degree with at least 45% marks for Part III or **BA. B.Sc (excluding alternative pattern) Degree with Malayalam in Part II** with at least 45% marks of this University or equivalent degree. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

2. **Students under Grade Scheme (CCSS):**

BA Malayalam Language & Literature (Core) Degree or BA. B.Sc (excluding alternative pattern) Degree with Malayalam as Common Course of this University or equivalent degree with **OPTION I**.

11) **M A Sanskrit**

1. **Students Under Marks Scheme:**

BA Sanskrit (Main) Degree with at least 45% marks for Part III or **BA. B.Sc (excluding alternative pattern) Degree with Sanskrit in Part II** with at least 45% marks of this University or equivalent degree. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5% . SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

2. Students under Grade Scheme (CCSS):

BA Sanskrit (Core) Degree or BA. B.Sc (excluding alternative pattern) Degree with Sanskrit as Common Course of this University or equivalent degree with **OPTION I.**

12) **M.Sc. Mathematics**

1. Students under Marks Scheme:

B.Sc. Degree of this University **with Mathematics (Main)** or equivalent degree with at least 50% marks for Part III (excluding subsidiaries). OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

2. Students under Grade Scheme (CCSS):

B.Sc. Degree of this University with **Mathematics (Core)** or equivalent degree with **OPTION 2.**
