### ORDER

As per U.O read as (1) above, the B.Tech course Regulations, scheme and syllabus with effect from 2014 was implemented.

As per paper read as (2) above, representations were received from the 5th semester B.Tech students of various Engineering Colleges to exempt them from the Rule under section 16 of the B.Tech regulations of 2014 admission onwards.

As per paper read (3) above, the Board of studies in Engineering (UG) in its meeting held on 08.12.2016, considered the matter of exemption from the the Rule under section 16 of the B.Tech regulation of 2014 onwards, that warrants a pass in 1& 2 semester for registering to sixth semester class. After a discussion, Board recommended to relax the above stipulation for this batch alone since,

(I)This is the last batch of B.Tech for the university of Calicut except for engineering college directly under the University

(II) Results of supplementary exams of combined 1&2 semesters are not yet published.

However, the Board of Engineering(UG) is of the opinion that such relaxation shall not be allowed in every similar case in future (taking this as precedence) as it might degrade the quality of education.

As per paper read 4th above, the Academic Council at its meeting held on 13.12.2016 resolved to approve the resolution of Board of Studies in Engineering(UG).

Sanction is therefore accorded for implementing the resolution of the Board of Studies in Engineering (UG) held on 08.12.2016(item No.3) duly approved by the Academic Council

Following orders are therefore issued .

1.B.Tech students under 2014 regulations are exempted from the condition that a pass in all subjects of combined first and second semesters is required for a student to become eligible for entry in to the sixth semester, except for lateral entry students.

2.This relaxation shall not be considered as a precedence for any similar case in future.

3.Rule 16 of the Regulation of B.Tech programme with effect from 2014 admission stands modified to this extent.
