ORDER

As per paper read as first above, Orders were issued for implementing the Regulations and syllabi of Bachelor of Tourism and Hotel Management under Choice Based Credit Semester System (CCSS UG) with effect from 2009 admission.

Vide paper read as second above, the Board of Studies in Hotel Management has resolved to increase the duration of Industrial Exposure Training (IET) of Bachelor of Tourism and Hotel Management Students from 45 days to three months with effect from 2012 admission onwards. The Board also resolved that during the six semesters of the total programme, every student shall undergo 3 months training either in Hotel or Tourism Industries.

As per paper read as third above, the meeting of the Faculty of Commerce and Management Studies held on 28.11.2013 discussed item No.3 of the minutes of the meeting of the Hotel Management held on 11.04.2013 and proposed a modification with regard to Industrial Exposure Training of Bachelor of Tourism and Hotel Management Students to the effect that the 3 months' training has to be completed by the students either in Tourism or in Hotel Industry in between the 4th and 5th semester including the summer vacation.

Vide paper read as fourth above, the Academic Council held on 20.03.2014 has approved the

minutes of the Faculty of Commerce and Management Studies held on 28.11.2013.

Sanction has therefore been accorded to increase the duration of Industrial Exposure Training (IET) of Bachelor of Tourism and Hotel Management Students from 45 days to three months to the effect that 3 months' training has to be completed by the students either in Tourism or in Hotel Industry in between the 4th and 5th semester including the summer vacation. The decision will be effective from 2012 admission onwards.
