**ORDER**

As per the paper read as 1<sup>st</sup>, Modified Rules and Regulations and Scheme of Examination of M.Ed course has been implemented w.e.f 2003-2004 admission onwards.

The Board of Studies in Education(PG) at its meeting vide paper read as 2<sup>nd</sup> , has approved the amendment in the existing Regulation of M.Ed Course, to add a "Time Schedule" to M.Ed Course under the subtitle "Scheme of Instruction" as detailed below.

**Time Schedule – M.Ed Semester course**

**Total number of working days – 210**

**I Semester :** Duration – **105 Working days– I term and II term**

**I Term** : 53 Working days. Teaching of papers I, II and III giving theoretical orientation to the research work. Conduct of seminars, assignment submission, and conduct of Terminal Test I.

**II Term** : 52 Working Days. Teaching of papers I,II and III, Topic Selection of dissertation and tool preparation. Completion of Seminars, assignment, and conduct of Terminal Test II.

Consolidation and publication of marks (internal) shall be completed by the last week of the semester. The mark list should be submitted to the Controller of Examination within one week. University Examination should be held within one month after the end of the first semester.

**II Semester** : Duration – 105 Working days

Second semester will commence on **106<sup>th</sup> Working day** of the course and will be spread over **Two Terms**.

**I Term** : 53 Days. Conduct of Project work (project may be undertaken preferably in the month of June – July i.e., during teaching practice of B.Ed students). Teaching of Optional papers I (O<sub>1</sub>) and Paper II (O<sub>2</sub>), Data Collection, conduct of seminars, submission of assignments, and conduct of Terminal Test I.

**II Term** : 52 days. Teaching of Optionals I and II. Completion of Seminars and Assignment. Conduct of Terminal Test II.

Consolidation and publication of marks (Internal) shall be completed by the last week of the semester and the mark list should be sent to the Controller of Examinations within one week.

Dissertation should be submitted 15 days before the end of the second semester. The defaulters in submission of dissertation, have to remit a fee of Rs.1000/- in favour of the Finance Officer, University of Calicut. A condonation of a maximum of 15 days is permitted for submission of Dissertation..

The above schedule will come in to effect from the 2011 Admission onwards.

The Vice Chancellor, considering the exigency, exercising the powers of the Academic Council, has approved the minutes subject to ratification by the Academic Council.

Sanction has, therefore, been accorded to implement the amendments in the existing Regulation of M.Ed Semester Course (under the subtitle “Scheme of Instruction”) to add a “Time Schedule” to MEd Course as detailed below.

#### **Time Schedule – M.Ed Semester course**

Total number of working days – 210

**I Semester** : Duration – **105 Working days– I term and II term**

**I Term** : 53 Working days. Teaching of papers I, II and III giving theoretical orientation to the research work. Conduct of seminars, assignment submission, and conduct of Terminal Test I.

**II Term** : 52 Working Days. Teaching of papers I,II and III, Topic Selection of dissertation and tool preparation. Completion of Seminars, assignment, and conduct of Terminal Test II.

Consolidation and publication of marks (internal) shall be completed by the last week of the semester. The mark list should be submitted to the Controller of Examination within one week. University Examination should be held within one month after the end of the second semester.

**II Semester** : Duration – 105 Working days

Second semester will commence on 106<sup>th</sup> Working day of the course and will be spread over **Two Terms**.

**I Term** : 53 Days. Conduct of Project work (project may be undertaken preferably in the month of June – July i.e., during teaching practice of B.Ed students). Teaching of Optional papers I (O<sub>1</sub>) and Paper II (O<sub>2</sub>), Data Collection, conduct of seminars, submission of assignments, and conduct of Terminal Test I.

**II Term** : 52 days. Teaching of Optionals I and II. Completion of Seminars and Assignment. Conduct of Terminal Test II.

Consolidation and publication of marks (Internal) shall be completed by the last week of the semester and the mark list should be sent to the Controller of Examinations within one week.

Dissertation should be submitted 15 days before the end of the second semester. The defaulters in submission of dissertation, have to remit a fee of Rs.1000/- in favour of the Finance Officer, University of Calicut. A condonation of a maximum of 15 days is permitted for submission of Dissertation.

The above schedule will come in to effect from the 2011 Admission onwards.
