**ORDER**

The Rules and Regulations for Ph.D Programme in Engineering (Full-time and Part-time) with effect from 2010 admission was implemented vide paper read as 1<sup>st</sup> above.

The meeting of the Board of Studies in Engineering(PG), held on 03-09-2014,vide paper read as 2<sup>nd</sup> above, in view of the scarcity of Research Guides and Research Centres in the field, resolved to amend the Ph.D. Regulations 2010, by appending Clause 32 and 33, as follows.

**Clause 32- RECOGNITION OF RESEARCH CENTRE :**

*32.1 All teaching/research departments/centres of the University are deemed to be research centres of this University.*

*32.2 Central and State funded Research Institutions, may be recognized as research Centre of the University of Calicut based on mutual agreements and upon a request.*

*32.3 There shall be a Research Recognition Committee for each subject with the following*

members 1) Director of Research 2) Chairman, Engineering Research Council, 3) One subject Experts to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor 4) One member of the syndicate, nominated by Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor as Chairman.

32.4 Teaching departments in the affiliated Engineering colleges of the University of Calicut may be recognized as research centres if they meet the following necessary requirements.

32.4.1 The college which is seeking recognition have been offering Engineering graduate programme for atleast 10 (ten) years under that department

32.4.2 The college which is seeking recognition in a department of engineering shall have an affiliated post graduate programme under that department and have been offering the PG programme for more than two years.

32.4.3 There must be at least one permanent full time teacher with Ph.D. degree in engineering in the subject, in that department.

32.4.4 The departments/centre should have adequate infrastructure and literature in that subject of study.

32.4.5 The institutions should provide sufficient facilities to the researchers and scholars and an undertaking in this regard shall be given to the university.

32.4.6 Once the Department / Institution is recognized as a research centre, it is imperative that the centre is actively involved in relevant research.

32.5 The effectiveness of the research centre may be assessed, once in every five years, by the Research Recognition Committee.

32.6 Recognition given to any research centre can be withdrawn if the expert committee gives a report stating that the centre is not discharging its responsibilities satisfactorily or the conditions for granting recognition as a research centre are violated.

32.7 However, the research scholars who have registered for PhD under the research guides of the de-recognized research centre shall be allowed to submit their thesis in due course of time subject to the validity period of registration.

32.8 Once the affiliation is lost as above, the research centre should start afresh for recognition as research centre.

32.9 Permanent affiliation may be granted if the centre has been found performing satisfactorily in two consecutive inspections

### **Clause 33 - RECOGNITION OF RESEARCH GUIDE:**

33.1 All permanent faculty members of the institute who possesses Ph.D. Degree from IISc/ IIT/NITs and have published a minimum of one paper (sole or multiple author) in peer reviewed journal with minimum of two years teaching & research experience, are eligible to guide Ph.D. level researchwork in the research centre.

33.2 For those who acquired PhD from other Institutions should have published a minimum of two papers (sole or multiple author) in peer reviewed journals.

33.3 The individual member of the faculty will have to submit the application for recognition as Research Guide, along with a detailed biodata/CV and academic/professional achievements through the /centre to the Director of Research.

33.4 Board of studies PG(Engg) will examine the cases and recommend the eligible ones for recognition and approval.

The Faculty of Engineering and the Academic Council have approved the above resolution of the Board of Studies in Engineering(PG), vide paper read as 3rd and 4th above at their meetings held on 01-01-2015 and 15-01-2015 respectively.

Therefore, sanction has been accorded for appending Clause 32 and 33 of the PhD Regulations in Engineering(Full-time and Part-time)-2010 as detailed below.

### **32 RECOGNITION OF RESEARCH RESEARCH CENTRE :**

*32.1 All teaching/research departments/centres of the University are deemed to be research centres of this University.*

*32.2 Central and State funded Research Institutions, may be recognized as research Centre of the University of Calicut based on mutual agreements and upon a request.*

*32.3 There shall be a Research Recognition Committee for each subject with the following members 1) Director of Research 2) Chairman, Engineering Research Council, 3) One subject Experts to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor 4) One member of the syndicate, nominated by Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor as Chairman.*

*32.4.6 Once the Department / Institution is recognized as a research centre, it is imperative that the centre is actively involved in relevant research.*

**33 RECOGNITION OF RESEARCH GUIDE:**

*33.1 All permanent faculty members of the institute who possesses Ph.D. Degree from IISc/ IIT/NITs and have published a minimum of one paper (sole or multiple author) in peer reviewed journal with minimum of two years teaching & research experience, are eligible to guide Ph.D. level researchwork in the research centre.*

*33.2 For those who acquired PhD from other Institutions should have published a minimum of two papers (sole or multiple author) in peer reviewed journals.*

*33.3 The individual member of the faculty will have to submit the application for recognition as Research Guide, along with a detailed biodata/CV and academic/professional achievements through the /centre to the Director of Research.*

*33.4 Board of studies PG(Engg) will examine the cases and recommend the eligible ones for recognition and approval.*
