First Term (from June 2009 to August 2009)

Third Term (from December 2009 to March 2010)

31.03.2010 (Wednesday) : Closing of colleges for Summer Vacation
Number of working days : 65 days
in Third term

(4 days in December, 20 in January, 19 in February and
22 in March)

To plan teaching activities, so as to cover 40% of the prescribed syllabi for the 1st year classes and 20% of the syllabi for the senior classes.

For senior classes the remaining period of the term after completing the syllabi shall be utilized for revision works.

Number of total working days during the academic year 2009-10 : 200 days

Other Activities

Academic monitoring will be arranged to see that classes take place regularly, portion completed proportionately and internal examinations conducted properly.

The co-curricular activities of the College Union also will be spread out during six months so that all their activities are completed by the end of February in a useful and creative manner.
